



Dear valued customer,

The WA On-demand Passenger Transport Levy is part of the new Transport (Road Passenger Services) Regulations.

It requires all on-demand transport providers to pay a temporary levy to the WA Government for each trip taken.

The Levy will commence on Monday 1 April 2019 and will fund the buyback of the Perth metropolitan taxi plates.

How does this affect you?

The Levy applies to the bookings for all on-demand trips in vehicles that seat 12 or less people (including the driver) and that start and finish in the Perth, Mandurah or Murray areas.

The Levy will be 10% of the fare for these trips to a maximum of \$10 per trip.

It is expected the Levy will apply for four years or until the buyback of the Perth metropolitan taxi plates is complete.

We would like to ask for your understanding about the impact and disruption that this government Levy may cause.
